

# Erase Objects

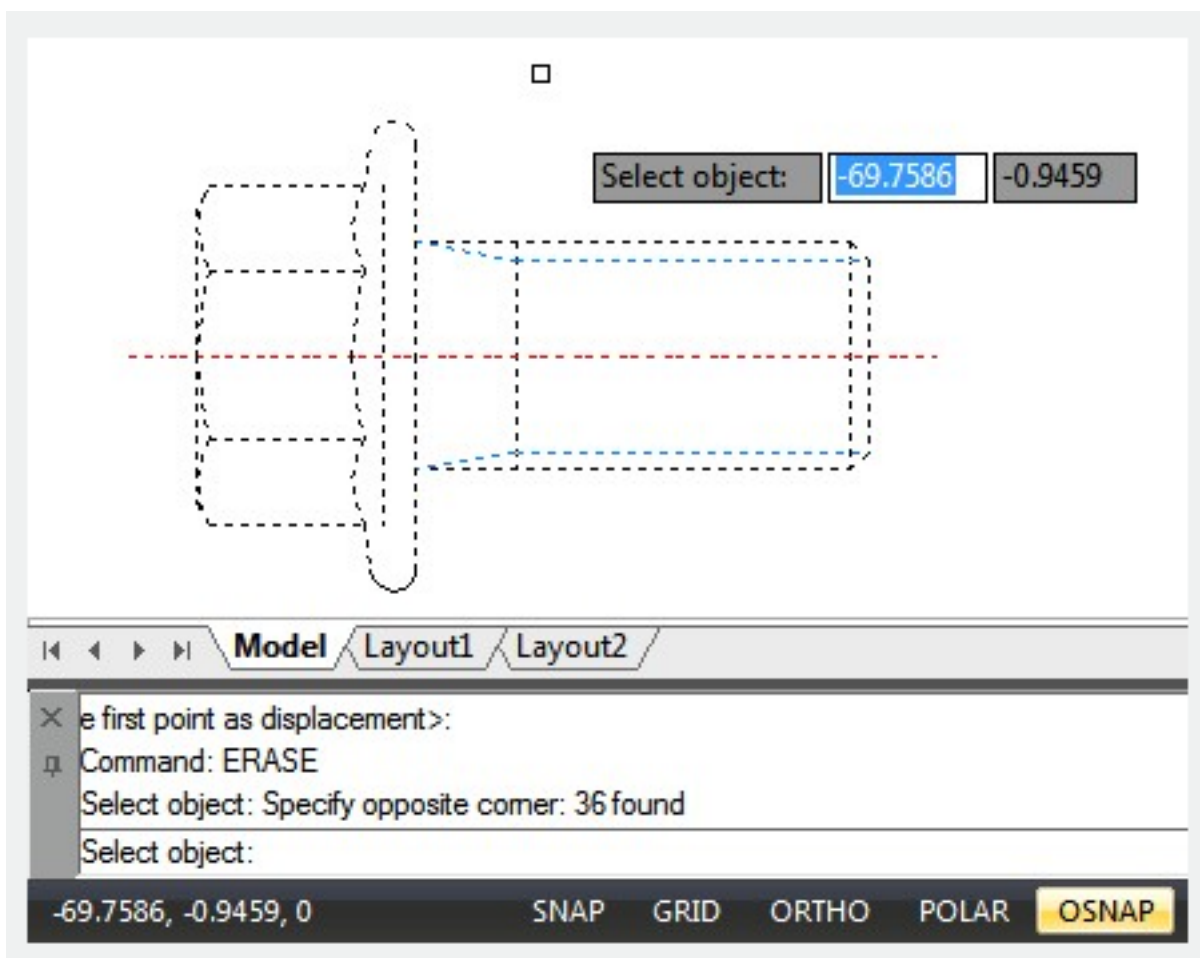

If you want to erase objects from your drawing, you can do one of the following .

Use the command [ERASE](#) .

Select objects and press DELETE.

Select objects and then cut them to the Clipboard with CTRL+X



Objects, which were recently erased with [ERASE](#) , [BLOCK](#) or [WBLOCK](#) can all be restored with the [OOPS](#) command.

Blips, which are plus-shaped markers and left over stray pixels that are displayed, can be removed by REDRAW ([REDRAWALL](#)) or [REGEN](#) .

Unused named Objects like block definitions, dimension styles ([DIMSTYLE](#)), layers ([LAYER](#)),

LINETYPE and TEXTSTYLE can be removed with the PURGE command.
